How To Configure an Amino STB No DHCP/Network



STEP-BY-STEP

Configuring the Set Top Box

1.

Plug a USB keyboard into the USB port of your set-top box.

2.

Connect the HDMI port on the set-top box to a HDMI port on your video display.

3.

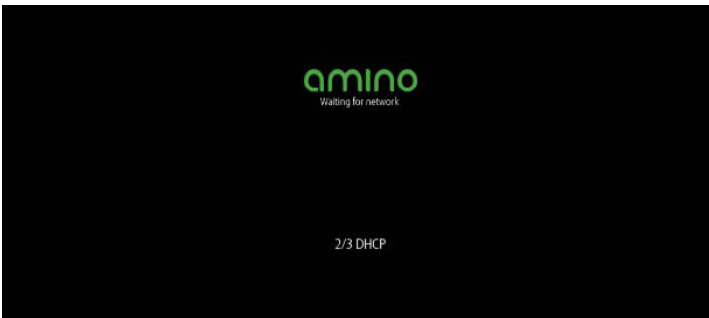
Connect the LAN port on the set-top box to the network (this is optional if pre-configuring off site).

4.

Connect the power supply to the STB.

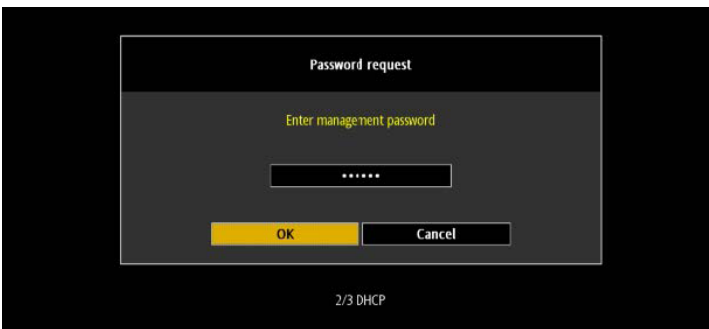
5.

Press **Alt-M** on the keyboard to access the Amino Management login.



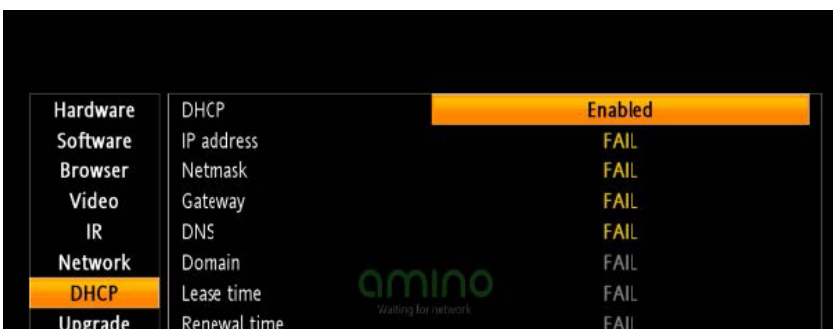
6.

In the password text box, enter the password (the default is leaves) and press Enter.



7.

The Amino Management screen appears, use the arrow keys to select the DHCP menu.



8.

To change the DHCP setting to disabled, Press Enter and then the Right Arrow Key.

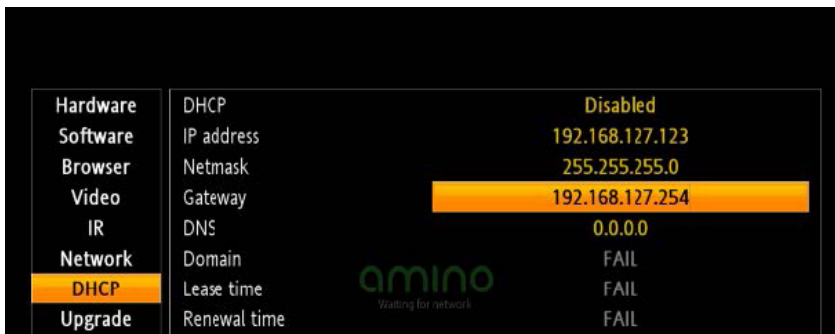


9.

Press enter again to confirm the new setting, you will be prompted for the 'write' password. The default is snake.

10.

Enter an IP address, Netmask, Gateway and (optional) DNS server settings for this STB.



11.

You must Press the Enter Key to confirm each new setting. If you just use the down arrow to the next setting the entries will be lost.

12.

When complete, the best practice is to select the Network Menu and then go back to the DHCP Menu to confirm that all the settings have been configured. If all is correct, you can now select restart.
